## Installing New Vehicle Definition Files

When you purchase a new Vehicle Definition File for the OBDII Tuner program you will receive an email with instructions for downloading the installation programs

To install your new Vehicle Definition File(s), double click on the installation program that you downloaded to begin the installation.

If you receive the following message:



Click on 'More info' and then click on the 'Run anyway' button to continue the installation.



If you then receive the following UAC message:



Click of the 'Yes' button to continue. The welcome screen with then be displayed:



Click the 'Next button to continue. The License Agreement screen with then be displayed.



Please review the license agreement and click on the 'Accept' button to continue. The next screen with show the folder into which the Vehicle Definition Files will be installed.

If you are running version 3.60 or later of the OBDII Tuner program, the Vehicle Definition Files must be installed into the 'C:\AppProg Data\CATS\OBD2Tuner' folder regardless of what folder the OBDII Tuner program itself was installed in. This will be the default install folder so you won't need to change it unless you are running an earlier version of the OBDII Tuner program.

If you are running an earlier version of the OBDII Tuner, the Vehicle Definition Files must be installed into the same folder as the OBDII Tuner program. By default this is 'C:\Program Files\CATS\OBD2Tuner' (or 'C:\Program Files (x86)\CATS\OBD2Tuner' on 64-bit Windows PCs).

If you changed the installation folder when you originally installed the OBDII Tuner then edit the folder specified in the 'Install files to this location:' box or click on the 'Browse' button to locate your OBDII Tuner folder. To verify the OBDII Tuner program folder right click on the OBDII Tuner icon on your Desktop and select 'Properties from the pop-up menu. This will display the Properties screen:
